- How to make the sign of the cross: Bring your thumb and first two fingers together (three together for the Triune God); touch your forehead (when saying "Father"), chest ("Son"), right shoulder ("Holy"), and left shoulder ("Spirit") or left to right, either way reminds us of our baptism into Christ!




