

Introduction

Becoming a confirmed Lutheran is merely one step in our life-long growth as Christians. Therefore, important things should be learned before, during, and after formal confirmation instruction. It is also important to make faithful application in our daily lives!

When Should Youth Begin?

I think it depends on the maturity of the youth; some may be ready as early as fifth grade, for others it may be more beneficial to wait until sixth or seventh grade. A way to test for readiness is for parents and students to work together to learn the contents of this brochure. Then ask yourself: How did that go? Does my child seem ready? Are we both ready to begin this important adventure in Christian growth?

 - ⇒ Because of sin.
- **5.** How did God take away our sins?
 - ⇒ God sent His only Son to live, die, and rise for our forgiveness.
- 6. How many books are in the Bible?
