Jesus is God's Son; He is the only way to heaven!

Introduction: Dear friends: The LORD said, "...be holy, for I am holy" (Lev. 11:44 ESV). God's Word teaches that **(B)we have all** done wrong, **(B)we have all** broken God's laws, and **(B)we have all** condemned ourselves. Therefore, no matter who we are, no matter what we do, we cannot save ourselves – *because we cannot make ourselves holy* **(B)**.

Therefore, in great love and with great power, God has provided our rescue through Jesus; He is the very Son of God in human flesh! <u>How can we know that is true</u>? Because, in today's epistle reading, we are going to consider three important forms of proof: (1) eyewitness testimony, (2) the actual voice of God, and (3) the Holy Scriptures. We could call them good, better, and best! May the Holy Spirit convince us that +all such things are true and +Jesus is our all-sufficient Savior!

1. <u>Good – Eye-Witness Testimony</u>: ¹⁶ For we did <u>not</u> follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the <u>power and coming</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ, but <u>we were eyewitnesses of his majesty</u> [greatness].

- a. <u>Jesus' ministry</u>: Peter and the other apostles were with Jesus during those years of ministry, *so they were eyewitnesses of countless amazing things*:
 - i. When Jesus met a man who could not walk, He forgave his sins and healed him; then the man stood up and walked (Luke 5:17-26)!
 - When Jesus wanted to go from one side of the Sea of Galilee to the other, but did not have a boat, He walked on the water (Matt. 14:22-32)!
 - iii. When a little girl was sick and then died, Jesus took her by the hand and life flowed back into her lifeless body (Mark 5:21-24, 35-43)!
- b. Jesus' power and coming: Can you imagine someone telling you about a person who *lived,
 *died, *was raised to life, *went to heaven, and
 *will eventually return to earth with great power? Sounds impossible, yet Peter wanted his readers to remember that he was an eyewitness of Jesus' greatness! He didn't just hear about Jesus' transfiguration, when "his face shown like the sun, and his clothes became white as light" (Matt. 17:2); instead, <u>Peter actually saw it with his very own eyes</u>! Therefore, let us know that ⇒Jesus is God, ⇒we are forgiven through Him, and ⇒He will come again!
- 2. <u>Better</u> The Voice of God the Father: ¹⁷ For when he [Jesus] received honor and glory from God the Father, and the voice was borne [uttered] to him by the Majestic Glory, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased," ¹⁸ we ourselves heard this very voice borne

[uttered] from heaven, for we were with him on the holy mountain. // In today's gospel reading Jesus took Peter, James, and John with Him up unto a high mountain. That is when \Rightarrow Jesus shown like the sun, \Rightarrow Moses and Elijah appeared with Jesus, and \Rightarrow God the Father spoke from heaven – \checkmark clearly identifying Jesus to be His beloved Son, \checkmark stating that He was pleased with Him, and \checkmark stating that we should listen to Him! Earlier, Peter stated that he saw Jesus' majesty with his very own eyes; here, Peter stated that he heard the very voice of God with his very own ears. Both realities are proof that Jesus is God's Son, the only way to heaven!

- 3. **<u>Best</u> The Prophetic Word**: From God and written!
 - a. <u>Pay attention</u>: ¹⁹ And we have the prophetic word more fully confirmed, to which you will do well to pay attention [to give heed, to follow] as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts...
 - i. The prophetic word is the OT Scriptures. Imagine being in a very dark place; then one match is lit. Your attention would immediately be drawn to that match! Here, we are talking about something much more important! As a match in the dark draws our attention for a moment, so, here, the Holy Scriptures should <u>keep drawing our attention</u> <u>until the return of Jesus</u>!
 - Dr. Kretzmann noted that the Word of God is "not truer [than Peter's eye-witness testimony or the voice of God], but it was

more certain, so far as the readers were concerned, than the doctrine taught by the apostles. [In other words], there was no question... that the OT prophecies, [thus] all the canonical books of the OT, were God's Word" (NT1:547). So Peter wanted his readers to know that what he taught *agreed with the Sacred Writings!*

b. <u>It is from God</u>: ²⁰ knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation [explanation]. ²¹ For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man [as if the prophecy originated with man], but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. // Many in the twenty-first century say the Bible is from men; that is their reason to ignore it. But God wants us to know that none of it originated with a man; instead, the Bible is God's Word, so it came ♦from God the Father ♦to the Holy Spirit ♦who moved men to write down the very words of God!

Conclusion: Our problem is sin; we can't fix it, so we need the Son of God to save us! Today, we heard about **†**the eyewitness account of Peter, **†**the voice of God the Father, and **†**the certainty of the Holy Scriptures; they all agree, **Jesus is the Promised Savior!**

Let us pray: Dear Father, impress upon us that good is NOT good enough; then, *being aware of our great need for Jesus*, let us ever-trust in Him! In Jesus' name, we pray...

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
