Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: We are so blessed to know Jesus as our Savior! Therefore, we → are spiritually hungry, → want to imitate Jesus, and → desire to tell others about God's great goodness!

- 1. Believers Hunger, Eat, and Grow Spiritually:
 - ² Like newborn infants, <u>long for the pure spiritual</u> <u>milk</u>, that by it you may grow up into salvation--³

grow up into salvation-- ³ if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good. //

a. Think about an infant: He is hungry, so he gets his mother's attention by crying, but picking him up is not enough, nor is he satisfied by his pacifier because his desire is for milk – for physical nourishment! Only that will satisfy and enable the child to grow up physically! Furthermore, the more he eats, the more he grows; and the more he grows, the more he eats! And how long does a human being continue to eat? Until he physically dies!

- b. Think about a believer: Infants are physically alive, while believers are spiritually alive so they *get hungry, *eat God's Word, and *grow up in Christ! As infants desire milk, so Peter is urging us as believers to long for spiritual milk, thus the nourishment of God's Holy Word!
 - i. <u>Parents: Feed your children!</u> If you are feeding them God's Word every day good; if not repent, change, turn to what they need as growing believers!
 - ii. Youth and Adults: God has taken action to make us alive in Christ; therefore, let us recognize our spiritual hunger, feed on God's Word every day, and be strong in Jesus Christ!
- 2. Believers Are Aligned with the Corner Stone: ⁴ As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and

precious, ⁵ you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. // So our building and many buildings have a cornerstone, but what was the ORIGINAL purpose of a cornerstone? "The cornerstone concept is derived from the first stone set in the construction of a masonry foundation, important since all other stones will be set in reference to this stone, thus determining

the position of the entire structure." Therefore, Jesus is the Cornerstone or Living stone – the One from which we have the gift of spiritual life! We have been placed in alignment with Him, as part of God's spiritual house, "to be a holy priesthood..." – to serve the Ultimate High Priest by +saying "yes" to His will and "no" to sin, +sharing God's Word, and +praying for those in need!

⁶ For it stands in Scripture:

- a. [Isaiah 28:16] "Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious, and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame." // Some people THINK they will be fine without Jesus but they will be shamed forever, while **believers** will be blessed forever!
- b. ⁷ So the honor [privilege] is for you who believe [we are so blessed through Jesus], but for those who do not believe,
 - i. [Psalm 118:22] "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone," // Some see Jesus as a loser - so they reject Him! But **believers**, even in the face of great difficulty, continue to believe in Jesus because He is the Ultimate Cornerstone!
 - ii. 8 and [Isaiah 8:14] "A stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense." [Then Peter commented: They stumble because they disobey the word, as they were destined to do. // To believers Jesus is

EVERYTHING, so they desire to obey the Word! But some are blinded to the truth about Jesus, so they reject Him and His ways!

3. Believers Announce God's Truth to Others: ⁹ But you are a chosen race [people], a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. // So, from conception, we were dead in our sins, but God has **t**united us to Jesus and **t**aligned us with Jesus; therefore, through Jesus, we ◆have received God's mercy and *are God's people! Now, overflowing with gratitude, we live out His blessed purpose for us: To "proclaim the excellencies of him who called [us] out of darkness into his marvelous light."

Conclusion: Now, knowing we are believers and forgiven in God's sight, let us *gladly* and *daily* → satisfy our spiritual hunger, →imitate our Lord Jesus, and →announce God's truth about our sin and His saving work to others!

And all God's people said: Amen!
