Revelation 11:1-19 NAS-95; Part 13 of 30

What is YOUR RESPONSE to God's Two Witnesses?

Thursday, 8/11 at 7 + Sunday, 8/14 at 8:00 & 10:45 9th Sunday after Pentecost / 8th Sunday after Trinity – 2011

Introduction: Dear friends in Christ, in chapter 10 we saw John eat the "little book," which was *sweet in his mouth* but *bitter in his stomach*. Regarding the bitter part, Eileen shared a great insight with me last week: Food is sweet when we eat it; however, when it becomes bitter in our stomachs, *it must come out!* That fits in perfectly with chapter 11 – as we read of God's Word *being proclaimed*, *coming out* to the world!

1. God's Two Witnesses Proclaim the Truth:

- a. Then there was given <u>me</u> [John] a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, "Get up and measure the temple of God and the altar, and those who worship in it. Leave out the court which is outside the temple and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread underfoot the holy city for <u>forty-two months</u> [the NT era]. Some parts are measured, one part is not; within the visible church (all who SAY they are Christians) are many who do not know Jesus Christ as Savior! (Becker, pgs. 164, 165)
- and I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy [the contents of the little book] for twelve hundred and sixty days [the NT era], clothed in sackcloth [a visible expression of repentance].
 These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord of the earth. So, WHO or

WHAT are the two witnesses? The two *means* or channels through which the H. S. works to ◆reveal sin and ◆unite to Christ, namely, Word and Sacrament! In today's world, most churches [©]pervert the Word or [©]deny the power of the Sacraments or [©]both!

c. And if anyone wants to harm them, fire flows out of their mouth and devours their enemies; so if anyone wants to harm them, he must [δεĩ, it is necessary] be killed in this way. These have the power [authority] to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall during the days of their prophesying; and they have power over the waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire." Let us understand the POWER of God's witnesses!

2. God's Two Witnesses are Put to Death:

- a. When they have finished their testimony [NAU Matt. 24:14 "This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come."], the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them [then evil will reign]. And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city [Jerusalem] which mystically spiritually? is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord was crucified. Dr. Becker explains WHEN the visible church will deserve to be called Sodom and Egypt, see pages 170-171 (today)!
- b. Those from the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations will look at their dead bodies for three and a half days [probably the "short time" of Rev. 20:3; compare 3.5 days (short time) with 1260 days (NT era) = 0.0028 x 2,011 = about 6 days], and will not permit their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb [since seeing their dead bodies will

make them happy]. And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them and celebrate; and they will send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth. How does Word and Sacrament torment unbelievers? Dr. Becker wrote: Their "message... <u>rebukes</u> [sharply blames or scolds] them either for their ungodly life or their wrong religious opinions" (172).

- God's Two Witnesses are Raised to Life: ¹¹ But after the 3. three and a half days, the breath of life from God came into them, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell upon those who were watching them [their coming to life will give "...evidence that their message had been divine and therefore, true." (Becker, 173)]. ¹² And they heard a loud voice from heaven [or the sky] saying to them, "Come up here." Then they went up into heaven in the cloud *[like* Jesus' ascension], and their enemies watched them. ¹³ And in that hour [when the two witnesses went up to heaven] there was a great earthquake [these are other "GREAT earthquake" references: Ezekiel 38:18-20; Luke 21:8-11, 25-28; Revelation 6:12; what about Elenin, see the 6-26-11 sermon], and a tenth of the city fell ["...the visible church is of itself not a place of safety" (Becker, 174), only Jesus Christ]; seven thousand people were killed in the earthquake, and the rest were terrified and gave glory to the God of heaven [NAU Phil. 2:11 "...every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord..." but not unto salvation]. ¹⁴ The second woe [trumpet six] is past; behold, the third woe [trumpet seven] is coming quickly.
- The Seventh Trumpet, the End of the World:
 - a. Then the seventh angel [8:2] sounded [NAU 1 Thess. 4:16 "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven...with the

trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first."]; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever." for And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God [4:4, 10; 5:8], fell on their faces and worshiped God, saying, "We give You thanks, O Lord God, the Almighty, who are [is] and who were [was], because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign. Finally, Christians on earth and in heaven will SEE the REALITY of what they BELIEVE!

¹⁸ And <u>the nations were enraged</u> [their status will finally b. be confirmed, they are the losers], and Your wrath came, and the time *came* for the dead to be judged, and *the* time to reward Your bond-servants [slaves] the prophets and the saints [namely] those who fear Your name, the small and the great ["All Christians. without regard for their importance in the eyes of the world will share in the reward." (Becker, 177)], and to destroy those who destroy the earth." ¹⁹ And the temple of God which is in heaven was opened; and the ark of His covenant appeared [was seen] in His temple, and there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder and an earthquake and a great hailstorm. Even though judgment is coming for unbelievers, LET US BE AT PEACE - because Jesus "loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood..." (Rev. 1:5 ESV).

Conclusion: And all God's people said: Amen!
