Holy Thursday – 2024 <u>Thursday</u>, 3/28 at 11 am & 7 pm



Introduction: Dear friends in Christ: In the last sermon I told you about the *secret plan* of *evil leaders* to *murder one man*.

- Then, in secret, they arrested that man!
- Then, illegally, they put Him on trial multiple times!
- Then, they declared Him guilty of blasphemy because He claimed to be the Christ, the Holy One of God!
- Now, no longer in secret, and having gained the support of an ignorant and heartless mob, that man will be taken to the governor.
- Now, the evil leaders must convince the governor to do their dirty work, to murder the man they hate!

The day is Good Friday; it's about 5 o'clock in the morning.

Day 33 (Fr, 3/22) – Jesus Delivered to Pilate: **15:1** Early in the morning $[\pi\rho\omega\tilde{t} - in Jewish time reckoning, the fourth watch of the night (from 3:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M.)] the chief priests with the$

elders and scribes and the whole Council, immediately held a consultation; and binding Jesus, they led Him away and delivered Him to <u>Pilate</u> [the Roman Governor]. // The Council had already decided to murder Jesus, <u>so why a consultation</u>? It was <u>illegal</u> to have a trial at <u>night</u> – *like the previous trials*. Therefore, to try to make things look legit, they met and confirmed their earlier decision – at the crack of dawn.

² Pilate questioned [Jesus], "Are You the King of the Jews?" And He answered him, "*It is as* you say." ³ The chief priests *began* to accuse Him harshly. ⁴ Then Pilate questioned Him again, saying, "Do You not answer? See how many charges they bring against You!" ⁵ But Jesus made no further answer; so Pilate was amazed.

- <u>Pilate didn't care about blasphemy</u>, the reason the Council had condemned Jesus, so they told Pilate about Jesus' claim to be the King of the Jews – trying to move Pilate to murder Jesus on their behalf.
- Whenever Jesus was asked a legitimate question, He answered. He is the King of the Jews (Matt. 2:2)!

Day 34 (Sa, 3/23) – Pilate Delivers Jesus to be Crucified: 15:6 Now at *the* feast [Pilate] used to release for them *any* one prisoner whom they requested. ⁷ The man named Barabbas had been imprisoned with the <u>insurrectionists</u> who had committed murder in <u>the insurrection</u> [a violet uprising against the Roman government]. ⁸ The crowd went up and began asking [Pilate] to do as he had been accustomed to do for them.

 Let's identify the crowd: It was a multitude, a large number, of common people who had been deceived by the evil Jewish leaders into thinking that Jesus was guilty and needed to die. We have a similar multitude in the USA who have been deceived into thinking ✓ the Bible is false, ✓ the BIG bang is true, ✓ there is no God, ✓ there is no eternity, ✓ there is no right and wrong, ✓ genders are not limited to male and female, ✓ abortion is not murder, and ✓ actions have no consequences. May the Holy Spirit intervene quickly and powerfully to ⇒open many closed ears, ⇒enlighten many ignorant minds, ⇒soften many hard hearts, and ⇒lead vast multitudes to repent and believe unto eternal life!

⁹ Pilate answered [the crowd], saying, **"Do you want me to release for you the King of the Jews?"** ¹⁰ For he was aware that the chief priests had handed Him over because of envy. ¹¹ But the chief priests stirred up the crowd *to ask* him to release Barabbas for them instead. // <u>The chief priests were</u> *evil leaders*, but, sadly, many believed their lies – *just like many in America today*. Let's make sure **+**our sources are reliable and **+**our information is accurate – *before taking a position*.

¹² Answering again, Pilate said to [the crowd], "Then what shall I do with Him whom you call the King of the Jews?" ¹³ They shouted back, "Crucify Him!" ¹⁴ But Pilate said to them, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they shouted all the more, "Crucify Him!" ¹⁵ Wishing to satisfy the crowd [and save his own skin, rather than maintain justice], Pilate released Barabbas for them, and after having Jesus scourged, he handed Him over to be crucified.

I find no guilt in Him: Pilate said that repeatedly about Jesus (Luke 23:4, 14, 22; John 18:38; 19:4, 6), but since his life and position were more important to him than justice, he gave in to the crowd. Jesus was scourged: *†*He was stripped of His clothes,
*†*His hands were tied to an upright post, and *†*He was very severely beaten!

Day 35 (Mo, 3/25) – Jesus Is Mocked: 15:16 The soldiers took [Jesus] away into the <u>palace</u> [courtyard] (that is, <u>the</u> <u>Praetorium</u>) [the governor's official residence], and they called together the whole Roman cohort [normally including 600 troops]. ¹⁷ They dressed Him up in <u>purple</u> [mocking His claim to be the King of the Jews], and after twisting a crown of thorns, they put it on Him; ¹⁸ and they began to [salute] Him, **"Hail, King of the** Jews!" ¹⁹ They kept beating His head with a reed [driving the thorns further into His head], and spitting on Him, and kneeling and bowing before Him. // The mocking by the soldiers was severe. After Jesus was crucified, many more mocked Him!

²⁰ After they had mocked Him, they took the purple robe off Him and put His *own* garments on Him. And they led Him out to <u>crucify Him</u> [to nail Him to a cross and make sure He stayed on the cross until He was dead].

Conclusion: What happened to Jesus was horrible, but it was all part of God's plan to ♥ rescue us from our sins and ♥ gift us with eternal life. The plan was ↑ made before creation, ↑ spoken in Eden, ↑ written down in the OT Scriptures, and ↑ perfectly followed by the Son of God wearing human flesh.

Let Us Pray: <u>Dear Father</u> – *TY for Your plan!* <u>Dear Jesus</u> – *TY for Your perfect obedience to the plan!* <u>Dear Holy Spirit</u> – *TY for gifting us with godly sorrow and saving faith in Jesus!*
