- d. Those who give bountifully / generously: NAS 2 Corinthians 9:6
 "Now this I say, he who sows sparingly shall also reap sparingly; and he who sows bountifully shall also reap bountifully."
- e. Those who *give more* also *gain more*: ^{NIV} Proverbs 11:24 "One man gives freely, yet gains even <u>more</u>..."
- Tithe-Giving and Offering-Giving are Different: In both cases we NEVER give to be saved; instead, <u>we give to honor</u> <u>the LORD who freely saved us by grace</u> <u>through faith in Jesus</u>!
 - a. <u>Tithe-giving</u> is giving 10% of whatever we receive; remember, *it belongs to the LORD* (Lev. 27:30).
 - b. <u>Offering-giving</u> is giving over and above the tithe / 10%. Offerings are given ◆for certain purposes or ◆on special occasions or ◆out of great gratitude.
 - Years ago, when visiting one of our members, he gave BLC an offering of \$88. Even though he faithfully gave a tithe, his 88th birthday was coming up; therefore, he gave out of gratitude for his years of life!
 - ii. <u>Another wonderful way</u> to give an offering is to support God's work after we are in paradise by designating a percentage of our estate to our congregation. Thanks in advance for your prayerful consideration!

 Disciples Give Cheerfully: As sinners we deserve nothing good, yet God has richly blessed us now and forever in Christ! Therefore, as we think about
 God's gifts, +His generosity in allowing us to keep 90%, and +His promise to provide all of our needs, we can give cheerfully! We are also encouraged by these words: NAS 2 Corinthians 9:7 "...God loves a cheerful giver."

Conclusion

At Bethlehem + the pastor gives a tithe, + the congregation *as a whole* gives a tithe (by giving more than 10% of what is received to various needs *outside* of the congregation), and + every member is *encouraged* to tithe!

Now that you know what the Bible says about giving, what will YOU do?

- → Hold back and worry! OR
- → Gladly step-out in faith: Trusting in God, believing His Word, following His Word, and looking forward to the reception of His promised blessings!

I know one couple who learned God's truth; then – *in one week* – increased their giving by 500%! *God is still richly blessing them*!

We are saved by the gospel – by grace through faith in Jesus for eternal life! But we live our Christian lives by the law – seeking, knowing, and following the Bible! Let us SHOW our faith and gratitude by faithfully living according to God's Word!

Tithing! Giving 10%

What Does the Bible Say?



Do you give <u>first</u>, <u>proportionately</u>, and <u>cheerfully</u>? Why? Why not?

Introduction

Dear friends, the Almighty God has freely given us ◆physical life, ◆the promise of eternal life through Jesus, and ◆all that we possess! So He calls us to acknowledge His goodness and show our gratitude by faithfully following His Word. Though many choose to hold back on their giving, God is promising blessings of **peace**, **joy**, and even **abundance** to those who follow the Bible!

Therefore, may the very words of God contained in this brochure *instruct us* and *encourage us*; then, may the Holy Spirit move us receive the promised blessings as we consistently give *first, *proportionately, and *cheerfully!

1. God Has Given Us Whatever We Have

- a. ^{NIV} Deuteronomy 8:17 "You may say to yourself, 'My power and the strength of my hands have produced this wealth for me.'
 ¹⁸ But remember <u>the LORD your</u> <u>God</u>, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth..."
- b. David prayed to the Lord:
 ^{NIV} 1 Chronicles 29:14 "Everything comes from you, and <u>we have</u> given you only what comes from your hand."

2. Faithful Giving is First-Fruits Giving:

NAS **Proverbs 3:9** "Honor the LORD from your wealth, And from the <u>first</u> of all your produce..." *Giving from our leftovers shows no faith!* We *honor* the Lord by giving to Him FIRST; then trusting Him to provide what we need!

- 3. Faithful Giving is Proportionate Giving: A person's GIVING should be based on his RECEIVING – wages, salary, pension, social security, inheritance, etc.!
 - a. ^{NIV} Deut. 16:17 "Each of you must bring a gift <u>in proportion</u> to the way the LORD your God has blessed you."
 - b. ^{NIV} 2 Corinthians 8:11 "Now finish the work [of giving] ...<u>according</u> to your means. ¹² ...the gift is acceptable according to what one has..."
 - So what portion should we give; what portion should we keep?
 Keep reading for God's answer!

- 4. Our Giving is a Test of Our Faith: God has given us 100% our share AND HIS SHARE. The Bible says: ^{NIV} Leviticus 27:30 "A tithe of everything...belongs to the LORD; it is holy to the LORD." The Lord could have held back His share, but, instead, He is testing us to see whether or not we will return 10% to Him. It's like being at a store and getting too much change; we know what we should do, <u>but what will we do</u>? Can we trust Jesus for eternal life, but not trust Him for our daily needs?
- 5. Pastors are also Commanded to Tithe: These words were spoken to the Levites, the OT priests: ^{NIV} Numbers 18:26 ... "When you receive from the Israelites the tithe I give you as your inheritance, you must present a tenth of that tithe as the LORD's offering." So the people were to give a tenth; then the priests were to give a tenth! That may sound like a lot, but let's put it in perspective:
 - Depending on your income, your 2013 tax rate is between 10% and 39.6%.
 - b. For good restaurant service you should tip 15-20%.
 - c. The 10% (the tithe) can seem so huge, yet God lets us keep 90%!God is so good us!

If We Do Not Tithe, We are Robbing from God: The Lord identified sin with these words: ^{NIV} Malachi 3:8 "Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me. "But you ask, 'How do we rob you?' "In

tithes and offerings." In other words, since the tithe belongs to the Lord, <u>we</u> <u>rob Him whenever we do not give a</u> <u>tenth from whatever we receive</u>!

7. Jesus Himself Endorsed Tithing: He said to the teachers of the law and Pharisees: ^{NIV} Matthew 23:23 "...You give a tenth of your spices--mint, dill and cummin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law--justice, mercy and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former – giving a tenth of everything, even of your spices." Jesus is calling us to be just, merciful, and faithful, as well as ones who tithe from all that we receive!

8. Great Blessings are Promised to Those Who Do Tithe<mark>:</mark>

- a. Those who honor the Lord in their giving: NAS Proverbs 3:10 "...your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine."
- b. Those who tithe: ^{NIV} Malachi 3:10 "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse...and see if <u>I will</u> not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it."
- c. Those who use a large measure: NIV Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you... For with the [same size] measure you use, it will be measured to you."
